LONG DISTANCE MOVING CHECKLIST



Make sure you've submitted your change of address forms as soon as possible and don't forget your subscription services.
Sell or throw out items you don't need anymore. The fewer items you have, the lower the cost your move will be.
Get moving quotes from at least 3 different companies or start pricing the cost of rental trucks and packing equipment if you're going DIY. Start making arrangements to have utilities
Start making arrangements to have utilities moved to your new home early. The last thing you'll want after a long drive is to find the WIFI isn't working.
Pack a moving day bag that includes items you might need on night one at your new home and any vital documents you need to keep on your person during your move.
When packing other boxes, label them by which room they belong in, which boxes are fragile, and which boxes need to be unpacked first when you reach your new home.
Use a tool like our Moving Inventory Tracker or a physical notebook to keep track of every item you pack.
AFTER moving, check smoke detectors, change locks and explore your new neighborhood!
